Private and Semi - Private Lesson Subscriptions

Private Lessons: \$260 Minimum 2 months

No Subscription: \$320 (4 lessons)

Includes:

1 Adult membership and 1 Child membership

Semi -Private Lessons: \$380 Minimum 2 months

No Subscription: \$500 (4 Lessons)

Includes:

1 Adult membership and 2 Children memberships

- Lessons are scheduled once a week for a duration of 30 minutes.
- Your account will be automatically charged a monthly subscription fee on either the 1st day
 or the 3rd Monday of each month. This is based on the start date of the lessons.
- To cancel your subscription, written notice must be given 10 days prior to the end of the month.
- No refunds will be given for subscription charges after the cancellation due date.
- A minimum of 24hrs notice is required prior to lesson for cancellations. A no show, no call will result in loss of lesson. (We understand emergencies and illnesses happen.)

Q&A

What if there are 5 weeks in a month?

If your lesson ends up to be on a 5th day of the month, then JACKPOT you win.

What if we miss due to sickness of either parties?

Every attempt will be made to reschedule the lesson in the same month by:

- o Doubling up in one week with another day that works for both participant and instructor.
- Having another instructor make up the lesson if instructor and participant are not able to reschedule.

If we are unable to reschedule a lesson:

- We will add the missed lesson(s) into a hold bucket to be used at the end of a month's subscription.
- If more than one lesson is missed, we will pause the monthly subscription to catch up. It will only be paused for the duration of the missed lessons and will AUTOMATICALLY resume charging for the next month if notice is not provided to cancel.

What benefits do I get with a membership?

Membership allows you to swim before and after lessons, as well as during any of our open swim times. (Times may be restricted or changed due to parties and lessons)

Can I do lessons twice a week?

Yes, as long as we have availability. This would be considered a double subscription.
